As we prepare to open school, the following will be imperative to the start of a successful year. Feel free to check off these time saving tips and policies as you navigate through the end of this letter.

All students must purchase the school bundle in order to maintain consistent communication between parents and teachers regarding your child's academic progress and behavior. In order to facilitate this and the many other **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** instructional resources, bundles will be for sale at your assigned parent orientation the week before school begins as well as online to purchase as of **August 1st**. If you purchase your bundle online please, bring confirmation and pick up your agenda and shirt on your orientation day. Our ASCP bundle includes a student agenda, first day of school picture, one Friday Fun Shirt, as well as the social studies/science weeklies, and school lanyard for one low price. Optional add-ons include annual “jean-day” and yearbook additions. See attached flier for more information.

All uniforms are to be purchased at Ibiley Uniforms located at, *11530 SW 120th St, Miami, FL 33176*. Remember, it is mandatory for students to be in full uniform every day. On Spirit t-shirt day students can wear their school spirit t-shirts. On Fridays, students also have an option of wearing jeans instead of uniform bottoms for a \$1.00 cash donation. All students will be assigned a day of the week to wear their PE uniforms, sixth grade students MAY have two days. Gala uniforms are to be worn on special occasions. This year, students in sixth grade will have some changes to their required uniforms. Please pay close attention to these changes, if you have any questions, please contact the main office.

We encourage all our parents to come to their corresponding day and time so they have the opportunity to meet their child's teachers and **drop off all supplies before the start of school**. This is also a great opportunity to take care of your bundle fees as we are accepting payments all day in our gymnasium on August 15th and 16th. We will be taking credit card payments on-site, so remember to bring your preferred payment option. Checks **WILL NOT** be accepted. Orientation presentations will provide parents with pertinent information regarding all policies and procedures including arrival, dismissal, visitor policies, assigned special events and the best way to ensure your child is ready.

ACSP proudly follows the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and orientation is the perfect opportunity to fill out and/or register for the lunch program. Please remember to bring all case numbers (SNAP, EBT, MEDICAID and income verifications) to your assigned orientation day as this information is necessary in filling out NSLP Forms and will ensure you keep your free and/or reduced status. All students must have a new lunch form on file at the start of every school year. Representatives from the ACSP before/after school care program will be on-hand as well.
