Distance Learning FAQs

When can my child go back to the school building? ACSP facilities will remain closed until at least April 15. In the event that that date is extended by officials, you will be notified and virtual learning will extend. Virtual learning will count as the child's "regular" school day.

Is Virtual Learning a regular "school"day? Yes, students' time online is able to be monitored and assignments are being collected. We ask that your child be present and engaged and follow proper virtual learning etiquette (helpful tips forthcoming).

Will assignments be graded? Yes, assignments will be collected virtually and graded. Grades will count for the upcoming grading period.

Does attendance count? Yes, attendance counts and will be monitored. Students are NOT expected to be online the entire school day, however, all teachers will be available virtually for live instruction and spot checks no less than 3 hours a day. Your child is expected to attend virtual learning daily and complete all assignments.

What accommodations for our ESOL and students with special needs? Students with accommodations have been provided content and instructional opportunities to ensure that there are no breaks in service, this includes all related services. Beginning the week of March 30, related services will be provided virtually from their current service provider. All students have direct access to their special education teachers through our required platforms.

What happens to SAT/FSA testing? All standardized testing has been cancelled for the 2020-2021 school year.

Can I check out a mobile device? No, ACSP has depleted our available mobile devices. We are no longer checking them out. However, all virtual learning live sessions and MOST of the required assignments are available through tablets and even smart phones. If you are having difficulties please reach out to your child's teacher so we can try to facilitate a solution.

How can I contact my child's teacher/s? All teachers can be communicated with through their emails and BLOOMZ.

How can I contact the school? The school has virtual school office hours from 9:00 am - 11:00 am and 1:00 pm-3:00 pm. If you are having difficulties or need direction please adhere to these times and call the main school number (305) 964-7542.
