

- 2. What effect does placing ancient mythology in modern-day context have on a story such as this? Use evidence from the novel to support your answer.
- 3. Why is Percy's mother such an important figure in his life? Use evidence from the novel to support your answer.
- 4. Compare and contrast any two obstacles that Percy faces. Describe each of them in detail using as many adjectives and descriptive language as possible. What are their similarities and differences? What do we learn about Percy in each obstacle you are comparing? What does Percy learn about himself in each obstacle you are comparing? Use evidence from the novel to support your explanations
- 5. What is the significance of friendship and betrayal in Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief? How do these two themes play out in the novel? Use evidence from the novel to support your answer.
